#### **Description**

#### **General Information**

- **Tier One** – primary intervention focuses on aiding children who are unable to meet set benchmark levels or special levels of program.
- **Tier Two** – secondary intervention focuses on aiding children who have not made adequate progress during primary intervention. The child is given additional instruction at 20-40 minute intervals in smaller group settings.
- **Tier Three**- tertiary intervention focuses on even smaller group, increased time in intervention (40-65 minute intervals) and one on one time teacher aid.
- Utilize the Texas Essential knowledge and Skills for Kindergarten Framework as a resource for its curriculum.
- Developing, participating in, and sustaining formal and informal partnership with state and local agencies, and the private sector.
